CLEAR GLASS vs NON-REFLECTIVE GLASS

There are two main types of glass that can be used in picture framing; clear glass and non-reflective glass. Clear glass, as the name suggests is standard clear float glass, and its surface is shiny and reflects the light.

Non-reflective is a treated glass that looks kind of foggy until you place a photo right underneath it and will not reflect the light as brightly or intensely as the standard glass.

Generally, most picture frames you buy will have the standard glass, but we are able to offer the non-reflective. This is especially useful if you would like to hang a picture that is near a window, or is near a light source, and I am sure you'd prefer to see the image in the frame, rather than a bright reflection.
